Bullying can be

..... verbal



- Calling people names
- Playing cruel jokes on people
- Threatening people

..... non verbal



- Ignoring people
- Embarrassing people in public
- Telling other people not to be friends with someone

..... physical



- Pushing
- Kicking, punching and hitting
- Taking or hiding someone's things

.. on the computer/social media



- Posting horrible or threatening messages on social media such as on Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat or Twitter
